Safety Brief: Forklift Work

Rules and Requirements

Prior to Operation

- All operators must receive site specific orientation- From GC
 - Hazards
 - Traffic
 - Egress paths
- o All lifts must be inspected prior to first use of the day
- Always read manual on first use
- OSHA requires a fire extinguisher on board
- Inspections must be documented
- Inspections must be submitted to GC daily
- Check the path of travel and set up area for terrain and conditions

■ Working on or around Forklifts

- Always wear seatbelts
- o Driver is the only person on board
- Never exceed lift capacity
- Level the lift prior to raising the boom
- Use outriggers when needed
- Other operators and signalers must be trained
- Never leave an elevated load
- Never allow anyone to walk under a raised load
- o Carry loads as close to the ground as possible and still maintain visibility
- Loads hoisted must be attached to the provided hook
- Drivers must signal with horn when coming around blind corners
- Drivers must operate at safe speeds for the working environment
